The National Junior Honor Society at School of Science and Technology is an organization that recognizes and promotes enthusiasm for scholarship, the desire to render service, leadership, and character in students. Each member is required to maintain a minimum of a 3.55 cumulative grade point average, complete at least 10 hours of community service with our NJHS Chapter per semester, pay yearly membership dues of \$10, attend every meeting, and be an example to others with respect to scholarship, service, leadership and character. Any member who falls below these standards shall be placed on probation by the chapter advisors. A student is allowed only one probationary period in his/her membership period, and a student may not be reconsidered for membership in the National Junior Honor Society after being dismissed.
